Students meet or exceed curricular standards and demonstrate continual growth within the cognitive, affective, and psychomotor domains.

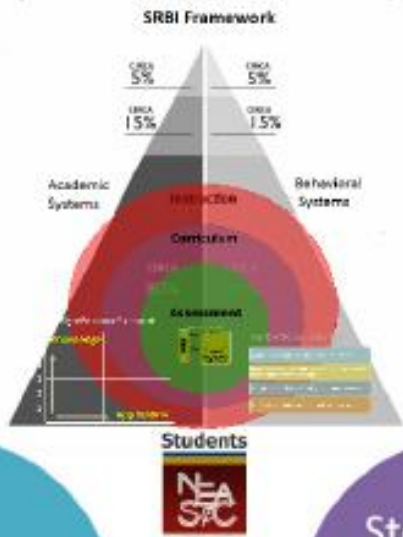
